A note to DV programs about DCF grant requirements and the LGBTQ webinar series (updated October 2019):

*Each contract period, **all** staff must complete additional training on providing welcoming, inclusive, and accessible services to survivors in the LGBTQ community. DCF partners with End Abuse each year to create a fresh, new webinar-based training that meets this requirement. Staff may watch the year's new webinar or view one of the archived webinars as a "refresher" (or for the first time if they haven't seen it). Programs may also offer their own training for staff that addresses the topic of "providing welcoming, inclusive, and accessible services to survivors in the LGBTQ community" to meet the annual requirement. Contact your contract administrator if you have questions about another training meeting grant requirement.*
